

## Character Clip from the Counselor

Because conflict is part of everyday life, it is important that students learn to recognize when they feel angry or hurt. The key sources of anger are stress, frustration, rejection, or isolation. It is equally important to talk to children about their true feelings and give them guided problem solving opportunities by modeling listening skills, perspective, negotiation and compromise, and finally, showing compassion.
